Dancers Etiquette

- 1) Dress appropriately and come prepared for class
- 2) Don't chew gum or bring food into the dance studio
- 3) No street shoes in the studio
- 4) Completely silence cell phones and leave them in a bag
- 5) Don't hang on the barre or sit down during class unless asked
- 6) Always use "Miss" when addressing a teacher, and say thank you after class
- 7) Don't yawn or show boredom in dance class



WHAT'S IN YOUR DANCE BAG?

- 1) Hair accessories – hair should always be up for class
- 2) Band-aides
- 3) Pain medicine and/or inhaler
- 4) Ladies necessities
- 5) Water bottle and/or money for snack
- 6) Appropriate dance shoes for each class
- 7) Deodorant

Dress Code Guidelines

Dress code: Dress code policies are provided when a student signs up for class. The reason for a dress code is that when a student is properly dressed, he/she is more prone to work hard in class and make every effort to learn. It is also a way of showing respect for the studio, the teacher and the entire class. In addition, proper attire allows teachers to monitor dance form and make adjustments correctly so that the student receives maximum benefit from class.

Female Dancers:

Creative Classes/Ballet

Leotard: Solid colored
Tights: Prima Pink, Black, Tan
(Revolution tights required for recital)
Shoes: Pink leather or canvas soft ballet shoes
Hair: Pulled back away from the face
Other: Skirt and dance shorts optional

Modern

Leotard: Solid colored
Tights: Prima Pink, Black, Tan
(Revolution tights required for recital)
Shoes: None
Hair: Pulled back away from the face
Other: Skirt and dance shorts optional

Jazz/Tap/Clogging

Leotard: Solid colored
Tights: Prima Pink, Black, Tan
(Revolution tights required for recital)
Shoes: Black Jazz and Tap, White Clogging
Hair: Pulled back away from the face
Other: Skirt and dance shorts optional

Hip Hop

Leotard: Solid colored
Tights: Prima Pink, Black, Tan
(Revolution tights required for recital)
Shoes: Black Jazz
Hair: Pulled back away from the face
Other: Dance shorts or sweat pants optional

Acro

Leotard: Solid colored
Tights: *Footless* Prima Pink, Black, Tan
(Revolution tights required for recital)
Shoes: None
Hair: Pulled back away from the face.
Other: Shorts optional - NO wristbands, necklaces.

Male Dancers:

Top: Solid colored t-shirt
Bottoms: Black pants
Shoes: Black ballet slippers for ballet, black jazz shoes for jazz and hip hop, black tap shoes for tap, white clogging shoes for clogging, barefoot for acro

Warm Ups: Dance warm ups may be worn at the beginning of class and removed when asked.
